



# A Pathway to Western Management and Organizational Studies



This information sheet has been designed specifically for Fanshawe Business-Accounting Diploma Program graduates who would like to be considered for admission to Year 3 of the 4-year Bachelor of Management and Organizational Studies (BMOS) under approved Articulation Agreements.

## STEP 1: APPLY

Make an application to **Year 1** of MOS through the OUAC (Ontario Universities Application Centre) at [ouac.on.ca/105](http://ouac.on.ca/105) by **March 1**.

Using the OUAC application, a request can be made to send mid-year Fanshawe transcripts to Western electronically. Please watch for the prompts and carefully note the timelines for sending transcripts.

## STEP 2: SUBMIT DOCUMENTS

Submit to **each** campus to which you are applying:

- ▶ Your mid-year Fanshawe transcript (unless requested through OUAC application previously)
- ▶ Your final high school transcript
- ▶ Any other documents requested in support of your application
- ▶ Western applicants only: Declaration of Intent: Diploma to Degree ([welcome.uwo.ca/admissions/forms](http://welcome.uwo.ca/admissions/forms))



## Admission Requirements

- ▶ Graduate of Fanshawe's 2-year Business – Accounting program;
- ▶ Completion of a prescribed set of courses within the Business-Accounting Diploma program within the two years immediately prior to applying;
- ▶ Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5;
- ▶ No grade less than "C" (or 2.0 GPA);
- ▶ Completion of Grade 12 Calculus & Vectors (MCV4U)\*;
- ▶ Letter of Endorsement from the Fanshawe Kinlin School of Business.

\* See FAQ #1 if you have not completed MCV4U.

## STEP 3: OBTAIN LETTER OF ENDORSEMENT

Contact Katrina Padyk at [k\\_padyk@fanshawec.ca](mailto:k_padyk@fanshawec.ca) to request a letter of endorsement from Fanshawe. The email must include your name, Fanshawe student number and your first choice campus.

Letters of endorsement will be sent after final Fanshawe grades have been posted.

## 1. What if I don't have the MCV4U math?

Options if you do not have the required grade 12 math course:

- I. Fanshawe offers an equivalent course, MATH3079, through the Lawrence Kinlin School of Business. Please contact Fanshawe regarding course registration.
- II. Wheable Adult Education Centre may also offer MCV4U; call 519-452-2660 for further information.
- III. You may be able to enroll in the course through the Independent Learning Centre ([www.ilc.org](http://www.ilc.org)) which is an online course of study offered through the Ontario Ministry of Education.
- IV. For equivalent courses taken outside of Canada, please contact the Admissions Office of the campus to which you have applied.

## 2. When will I receive an offer of Admission?

Conditional offers of admission to general programs begin in January. Final offers will be sent when the conditions of admission under this articulation agreement are met and endorsement letters are received.

## 3. Is there a situation where I would not receive a letter of endorsement from Fanshawe?

You may not receive a letter of endorsement if an academic offence has been recorded against you. These cases will be dealt with on an individual basis.

## 4. I'm graduating in August. Can I still apply for a September start?

If you are graduating in August and you meet the requirements, you may be admitted to either King's or Huron provided they have space and you are able to provide their Admissions Office with your final transcript before classes begin in September. It is your responsibility to inform King's/Huron if this situation applies to you. Contact your Program Coordinator as soon as final grades are posted in August and they will contact the Registrar's Office asking that your record be updated to show you are a graduate of the program. It is your responsibility to obtain a copy of your official transcript and deliver it to King's/Huron.

## 5. I have previously attended another university. Am I eligible for consideration under this Agreement?

These Agreements have been developed as a pathway for applicants without previous university experience. If you have attended another post-secondary institution prior to your attendance at Fanshawe, please contact the Admissions Office of the campus you wish to attend.
